# West Philadelphia Mennonite Fellowship September 13, 2017 Church Council Meeting Minutes

Tim began meeting at 7:05 with a reading and reflection from Ecclesiastes 3 followed by prayer.

#### HRC

- Several ministry positions have been filled which includes fellowship meal coordinators, coffee/tea setup, and mentoring coordinators.
- HRC is seeking a third person to serve on their team.

## Deacons

- Since informing the congregation of our budget concerns and deficit, we received an increase in one-time gifts. We are still missing budget, but are in a better position than before.
- Began process of training two people for custodian/sound staff position.

#### Pastoral team

- Nick is now licensed through Franconia Conference for a two-year period toward ordination. This will be recognized in the coming weeks during a Worship service.
- A small group survey was conducted and had 22 responses, Lorie briefly summarized some aspects of the survey.
- Dorianna will email out survey results to church council.

## **Anti-racism Trainings**

- Pastor Lorie handed out letter summarizing some of the goals and purpose of trainings for the next few weeks. She also gave some background on this initiative.
- Since the Anti-racism training earlier this year, a group has met a few times to discuss. There has also been a movie and discussion group happen over the past few months.
- Group has been in contact with Kara from anti-racism training.
- Would like to have focus groups, as well as reach groups that are already meeting regularly.
- Would like to get a sense of how our congregation perceives WPMF and the larger society in relation to racism.
- Focus will be to gauge the congregation's desire and interest in evaluating how and if our practices and church structures contribute to racism.
- Goal is to have a facilitator and note taker for each group meeting.

- One suggestion was to work with a peer congregation from kingdom builders for support.
- Another suggestion was to discuss this at retreat.
- Council agreed to focus on this topic. They also agreed that the next council meeting would focus on discussing this as a small group.
- Some members of WPMF had participated in an anti-racism training over ten years ago and it was approached differently than what we are currently proposing.
- One comment noted that we need to focus on goals and not get caught up too much in talking.
- Council discussed how talking was a necessary and valuable step and many agreed that it is important to determine specific goals from upcoming discussions and discernment.
- The next council meeting will focus on anti-racism small group discussion on Wednesday, October 25<sup>th</sup> at 7:00pm.

## Conversation with Franconia Conference

- Tim explained that we sent a letter to conference informing them of our congregational decision in favor of our pastor marrying a same-sex couple.
- Tim spoke with conference minister and they shared the letter with other Franconia conference leaders.
- The next steps are to meet and discuss with conference leaders. Council will be informed of when this meeting will happen and invite them to participate.
