Discussed Ministry Groups – Received updates from the various groups on what has been happening since the last Pastoral team meeting.

Discussed feedback from Sunday school class regarding preparation for Redemption Housing.

- One of the points to highlight is the desire to "Balance Jesus and Justice." We discussed having future sermons around these topics be theologically based, while having more pragmatic speakers join for workshops and/or Sunday School.
- Another point from the congregation was to create a steering committee to help the congregation with some of the issues brought up at the meeting. Lorie will follow up with the Redemption Housing committee about how they see their role in this.

Decided to approve a request for a mutual aid scholarship up to the amount of the conference fee (decided against giving aid for travel). Lorie will refer to the deacons to decide on the final amount to be disbursed.

Discussed pastoral care issues and ways to support households with on-going struggles.

Discussed the marriage enrichment seminar. Amanda will follow up with the SS leaders regarding child care and with Gwen White about her fee.

Lorie spoke about her desire to host an Election Day Communion, and the elders supported this idea.
